The bidder should be India based reputed Original vehicle Manufacturer (OEM) and should be in business of vehicles manufacturer and maintenance of the offered service for minimum period of three years in India proceeding to the bid calling dated and should have capacity of body building and fabrication of vehicle.
3. The Bidder must have manufactured/sold at least 500 similar type of base vehicles per year during the last three financial years (proof of the PO copies and relevant documents to be submitted) of 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21.
4. Signed and stamped tender document on all pages and enlisted hard copy of each documents should be submitted in Buyers Office on or before opening of Technical Bid.
5. IT returns and financial statement for last three financial years, 2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20.

8. Certificate of approval from ARAI for the vehicle proposed to supply.
9. Enclose Affidvit on Rs. 100 Non Judicial Stamp regarding Bidders is not black listed by any Government or its agencies.
